

Melanie: I am the co-founder and CEO of Canva, a platform that makes graphic design easy and fast for everyone. I live in Sydney, Australia. I like kitesurfing and travellina.

Steven: 2

Melanie: Umm... Actually, it was long ago... Everything started when I was just a university student.

Steven: As far as I know, the current worth of the company is

over \$40 billion now.

Melanie: Well, it is both hard and very rewarding at the same time. It has been years since we started planning it, but finding the investors and innovative engineers was really difficult.

Steven: I see. It seems that it took a long time to convince the investors.


