1988 yılında Zonguldak'ın Ereğli ilçesinde doğmuş, İstanbul'da büyümüştür. Evli ve bir çocuk annesidir. İstanbul Üniversitesi İngiliz Dili ve Edebiyatı bölümünden 2010 yılında mezun olduktan sonra yüksek lisansını Yeditepe Üniversitesi Radyo, Sinema ve Televizyon bölümünde tamamlamıştır. Burada kahramanlık hikâyelerinin toplumsal temellerini araştırmış ve programı onur derecesiyle bitirmiştir.

Daha sonra aynı üniversitenin Medya Çalışmaları Doktora Programı'nda eğitimine devam etmiştir. Doktora tezini yazarken Türkiye'nin farklı illerine giderek, ortaokul öğrencileriyle odak grup çalışmaları yapmıştır. Stereotiplerin, gençlerin iyilik ve kötülük algılarını nasıl etkilediğini anlamak amacıyla sürdürdüğü bu akademik çalışması, aynı zamanda yazdığı kitaplara ilham kaynağı olmuştur.

Yazar, üniversitede ayrıca pedagojik formasyon eğitimi almış, 4 yıl okutman olarak 'Eleştirel Düşünme ve Akademik Yazım' üzerine lisans dersleri vermiş, ardından 2 yıl ortaokul düzeyinde İngilizce öğretmeni olarak çalışmıştır. İngilizce eğitimini eğlenceli bir hâle getirmeyi hedefleyen 3 kitaplık *Fictional Marathon* serisinin yanı sıra, gençler için Türkçe romanlar da yazmaktadır.



Arda: Because you look like a woman in a famous **painting**.



One week later...


Arda and Enigmatic are waiting at the port.


