

Chocolate might not be the healthiest thing for your waistline, but a study following more than 37,000 Swedish people showed those eating the most chocolate were the least likely to have a stroke. It follows on from other studies that have suggested eating dark chocolate can improve the health of the heart. However, researchers warned the findings were not an excuse to overeat chocolate. Everyone taking part in the study were split into four groups based on the amount of chocolate, with the bottom group eating, on average, no chocolate each week and the top group having slightly more than an average bar. Comparing the groups showed that those eating the most chocolate were 17% less likely to have a stroke during the study. The researchers said that the beneficial effect of chocolate consumption on stroke may be related to the flavonoids in chocolate. It's also possible that the substance may decrease blood concentrations of bad cholesterol and reduce blood pressure.
